# **ELC - Remote Learning commencing 11th January**

We hope that you have had an enjoyable festive break and we look forward to starting the new term. Following the announcement from the Scottish Government regarding remote learning provision from  $11^{th}$  January, we have formulated the details of what we plan to provide from Monday  $11^{th}$  January until Friday  $29^{th}$  January. At present, we understand that the ELC will reopen for face to face learning on Monday  $1^{st}$  February.

The only exceptions are for children of key workers and vulnerable children in the ELC, Primary and Academy who will be able to attend in person from Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January. Details regarding registration for key worker children were emailed to these parents separately.

#### How to Contact Us:

The main form of communication with the ELC staff will be messages on ClassDojo. If you would like to share photos of, or information about, your child's learning at home with the ELC team please do so by messaging. Photos can be taken using the app, or uploaded, to a ClassDojo message.

Information will be shared about how to upload home learning straight into your child's portfolio on ClassDojo, which will remain with your child when they move into Primary 1.

If you do not have access to Class Dojo and wish to speak to the ELC staff or share learning from home, please get in touch by contacting the school office by email: <a href="mailto:gw08officewallacehal@ea.dumgal.sch.uk">gw08officewallacehal@ea.dumgal.sch.uk</a>.

ELC staff will be available between 8:30am and 3:30pm. They may not be able to respond straight away, but will aim to respond as soon as they can. If you contact us outside these times, it may be the next day before we are able to respond.

Miss Weir and Mrs Meredith can be contacted as usual regarding any queries or concerns that parents and carers may have. Please phone or email the office to get in touch. Please do not hesitate to get in touch if you need technical help and we will try to support you as much as we can.

## Learning experiences for children in the ELC

You will also receive a log in to Purple Mash, an award-winning educational website, for your child by email. Your child will be able to access a number of child-friendly online activities and tools to help their learning using the 'Mini-Mash' area of the website. This can be accessed at any time. The ELC and Primary school have recently purchased this subscription and we would like to thank the Parent Council for their generous contribution towards purchasing this online resource.
